



International Languages – Elementary/African Heritage Program

Summer Remote Learning: July 6 – July 31, 2020

The International Languages – Elementary / African Heritage Program will be offering language classes to students (TDSB and non TDSB) Kindergarten to Grade 8 (as of Sept 2019). Students will take part in remote learning with their classmates. Each day they will have live face-to-face interactive lessons with their instructor and other students for approximately 30 minutes. Activities will be focused on building student’s abilities in oral communication, reading and writing. Students will be provided with engaging activities on the theme “Life on Earth: We are all connected”. They will also be encouraged to get up, get outside and do hands on and research based activities throughout the summer program. Previous knowledge/background of the language is not required.

Date: July 6 to 31 (Monday to Friday)

Program Schedule: 9:30 – 12 noon or 1:30 to 4 pm

Location: Face-to-Face Online Learning. There may be a possibility that classes will move to a physical classroom. Families will have the option to continue learning from home.

Who: JK to Grade 8 Students (as of Sept 2019) TDSB and non TDSB students

Languages Offered: African Heritage, Albanian, American Sign Language, Amharic, Arabic, Aramaic, Armenian, Azerbaijan, Bengali, Bosnian, Bulgarian, Cantonese, Creole, Dari, Dutch, Edo, Farsi/Persian, German, Greek, Gujarati, Hebrew, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Karen, Korean, Kurdish, Macedonian, Mandarin (Simplified and Traditional) Mongolian, Marathi, Nepalese, Pashtu, Portuguese, Punjabi, Romanian, Russian, Sanskrit, Serbian, Shona, Sinhalese, Somali, Spanish, Swedish, Tagalog, Tamil, Telugu, Tibetan, Tigrinya, Turkish, Twi, Urdu, and Vietnamese.

A minimum of 23 students is required to offer a language class.
